The Troubled World and the Peace Giving Christ

John 6:16-21

16 And when evening fell, His disciples went down to the sea,

17 And they got into a boat and began crossing the sea to Capernaum. And it had already become dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them.

18 And because a strong wind was blowing, the sea was churning.

19 Then, when they had rowed about twenty-five or thirty stadia, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they became frightened.

20 But He said to them, It is I. Do not be afraid.

21 Then they were willing to take Him into the boat; and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going.

The churning of the sea signifies the troubles in human life

John 6:17-18

17 And they got into a boat and began crossing the sea to Capernaum. And it had already become dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them.

18 And because **a strong wind was blowing, the sea was churning.**

Matt 14:24

24 Now the boat was already in the midst of the sea, **being battered by the waves, for the wind was contrary.**

Mark 6:48a

48 And seeing them distressed as they rowed, **for the wind was contrary to them...**

The Lord can walk on the troubling waves of human life, and all the troubles are under His feet

John 6:19-21

19 Then, when they had rowed about twenty-five or thirty stadia, they saw **Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat**, and they became frightened.

20 But He said to them, It is I. Do not be afraid.

Matthew 14:25

25 And in the fourth watch of the night **He came to them, walking on the sea**.

Mark 6:48b

48 ...He came toward them about the fourth watch of the night, **walking on the sea**, and He intended to pass by them.

When we take the Lord into our “boat” we enjoy peace with Him on the journey of human life

John 6:21

21 Then they were willing to take Him into the boat; and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going.

Matthew 14:32-33

32 And when they got up into the boat, the wind ceased.

33 And those who were in the boat worshipped Him, saying, Truly You are the Son of God.

Mark 6:50-51a

50 For they all saw Him and were startled. But immediately He spoke with them and said to them, Take courage. **It is I. Do not be afraid.**

51 And **He went up unto them into the boat, and the wind ceased.** And they were greatly astonished in themselves beyond measure,
